## Oregon State Hanmadang archery competition rules

Equipment: -it is recommended that all competitors provide their own equipment, but in case of malfunctioning or defective equipment some bows and arrows may be available.

- -only traditional bow is allowed "no compounds or trigger release mechanisms. No pin, sight, or any aim assistance are allowed.
  - -competitors will need bow and minimum 6 arrows to compete.
  - -all equipment will be inspected for defect before competition.

## safety:

- -no arrows will be allowed to be knocked until referees instruction to begin.
- -archers must only face target until finished loosing all arrows or instructed to stop by referee or judge.
- -extra precaution all competitors stay behind shooting lines until range is deemed clear by referee or and judge.
- -no knocking of arrows while competitors, referee, or judges are in front of shooting line.
- -an infraction of any of the above safety rules could result in penalty or immediate disqualification on referee, judges, or tournament managements discretion.

## scoring:

- -each competitor will be provided there own score sheet.
- -score-sheet will be presented to judges prior to shoot, and attached to target.

-referee or judges will retrieve and score sheet after each archers shoot is completed.

-scoring is  $\underline{10 \text{ points for center}}$  circle and counting down one point for each ring outward on target "score sheet"

-each competitor will be given 60 seconds to loose 6 arrows on target. One bonus point will be awarded for every 10 seconds under the 60 seconds given, rounding down, so that if a person completes the round with 14 seconds to spare, 1 bonus point will be rewarded . In turn one point penalty for every 10 seconds over the allotted time given.
